4 Participation Fee

■ Athletes : €250 per person

(Competition entry Fee €50, Accommodation, Meal & Transportation Fee €200)

■ Officials : €200 per person (including Manager, Coach and others)

(for the Accommodation, Meal & Transportation)

※ €200 includes

- Accommodation : 3 nights and 4 days from Friday 14th Jan. to Monday 17th Jan.
 - A triple room with three beds is standard.
 - Additional 10 euros per night per person for a twin room with two beds.
 - Additional 20 euros per night for a single room.
(Single room is available only at Juwangsan Spa Hotel)
 - 30 euro per night per person for additional nights before 14th Jan.
(Room only, not including meals)
 - Room will be provided on a first-com-first-served basis.
- Meals : From Lunch 14th Jan.(Fri) to Breakfast 17th Jan.(Mon)
- Transportation : All transportation will be provided by K.A.F

■ The UIAA License Fee(€50) will be charged to All Athletes.

■ Cash in Euros is ONLY accepted.

5 Transportation

■ Incheon Int' l Airport to The Facility for PCR Test & Isolation

- All participants from foreign countries are required to move to the designated place for PCR test and stay until the negative test result comes out. The expenses will be covered by Korean government and the K.A.F.
- KAF will provide a special transportation service from the Incheon Int' l Airport terminals where the teams arrive, to the special facility for the PCR test and isolation until the test result comes out(maximum 24 hours)

■ To Cheongsong

- Provided shuttle service from the facility where the teams stay for PCR test, to each hotel in Cheongsong: Mt.Juwang Spa Hotel(UIAA Officials) and NCF Training Center(Teams)
- The schedule will be provided when we finish collecting the travel information from all NFs.

■ From Cheongsong to Incheon Int' l Airport

1. February 27th.
 - The BUS will depart directly to the Incheon Int'l Airport after the Award Ceremony finish (The time will be notified.)
2. February 28th.
 - Several buses will be provided to accommodate all participants who leave Korea on February 28th (The schedule will be notified.)

7 Covid-19 Information

BEFORE TRAVELLING

The athletes and officials who participate in UIAA Ice Climbing World Cup in Cheongsong will be allowed to enter Republic of Korea without two-week quarantine no matter they are fully vaccinated or not. However, we strongly recommend the participants be vaccinated before the World Cup circuit.

1. National team managers must provide us the information of participants on the goggle forms that UIAA provided together with the copy of passports and flight booking(not e-ticket) sheet by **the 21st of January** via kockaf@kaf.or.kr.
2. Korea Alpine Federation will send you all mandatory documents filled with the information the athletes/officials provided by **the 28th of January**.
 - Quarantine Exemption Application
 - Agreement to the Terms and Conditions
 - Quarantine Exemption Certificate
3. All athletes/officials have the documents signed and send back to us with **the e-tickets** by **the 4th of February** so that Korea Alpine Federation shall submit them to the relevant governmental authorities.
4. Once the waiver is approved by the relevant authorities, they will be sent directly to athletes/officials via their email addresses from the Korean Embassy and/or consulate which was designated in the application.

All Travellers to the Republic of Korea must be able to provide:

- Proof of a **negative Polymerase Chain Reaction(PCR), LAMP, TMA, NEAR test result in English or Korean taken within 3-days of the departure date** to enter the Republic of Korea.

UPON ARRIVAL

All travellers should have their approved Quarantine Exemption Certificate for entry into the Republic of Korea. You will need to present the Certificate when you go through customs. Proof of a negative polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) test result from everyone within 72-hours of your departure from the country.

When you arrive in the Republic of Korea, K.A.F will arrange an additional PCR test at the designated test facility near the airport where you will stay one night until the result comes out next day.

While staying in the facility, you are not allowed to be out of your room and all meals will be served directly to the rooms. Do not post your staying on the social networks while you stay and after you leave.

The transportation from the terminal to the facility, test expenses as well as meals occurred will be covered by the Korean government and K.A.F. All participants should arrive in Korea no later than the 24th of February(Day time).

About noon on the 24th of February, the last shuttle will leave for Cheongsong.

DURING THE EVENT

Additional measures of the organizer are as follows:

- Temperature checks of everyone on a daily basis, when entering the competition venue.
- Masks are required at all times at the competition venue and in public according to the Infection prevention guidelines
- You comply with all the obligations specified under the Note on the Quarantine Exemption Certificate.
- The PCR test for entry into the country athletes/officials come from, will be arranged on 25th and/or 26th so that you can get the result on the 27th at the latest.
