The following represents the pathway to be become a UIAA Aspirant International Routesetter or Judge, progress to become a UIAA International Route-setter or Judge and finally reach the expert level of UIAA International Chief Route-setter or Jury President.

Judges & Route-setter Course(s) will be organised by the UIAA. These course(s) and <u>venue(s)</u> will officially be announced by the UIAA.

Interested in Routesetting or Judging

- Contact UIAA and express interest in becoming a UIAA Official and attend a UIAA Route Setting or Judging Course and fulfill prerequistes for the course:
- Route setting or Judging experience at a national level
- Other appropriate qualifications IRATA, Lift certification etc.

UIAA Aspirant International Route Setter or Judge

- Attendance of Advanced Course at one of the official venues, which will include:
- · Advanced Theory: 1-3 days of education
- Practical Application: 1-3 days experience at the official UIAA Ice climbing Event
- Attendee course assessment [pass/fail]

Certificate of Attendance Denomination of "UIAA Aspirant Route-setter"

- Practical Application: attend 2 different events (and venues) over maximum of 2 years
- Report by Chief Route Setter or President of Jury on the following elements assessment -Excellent/Good/Fair/Poor:
- Understanding and implication of current UIAA Ice Climbing Competition Regulations

- To become Cheif Route Setter or Jury President:
- Experience of minimum 4 years of Route-Setting or Judging at international level
- Active application of Route-Setting or Judging expertise at 10+ events over maximum of 4 years
