Food

Food will be available **on the competition** site at **times adapted** to the competition. Reservations are **required before January 22, 2025**. Don't forget to make reservations at the following link:

The chef team is made up of a refuge kitchen chef and a team of volunteers. The objective is to introduce you to French food at the best price.

We are committed to offering local and environmentally friendly products:

- 80% of the food will come from local sources, with 50% organic.
- A vegetarian option will be available for every meal (on request).
- 100% homemade desserts.
- 100% locally sourced meat.
- Our local partners: Biocoop, the Prévot butcher shop in Moutier, the Planay brewery and charcuterie, and the Champagne-en-Vanoise bakery.

The number of meals will be made according to the number of online reservations. It will therefore not be possible to buy your meals on site at the last minute. All meal must be ordered in advance via the website above.

We are putting forward this policy in order to limit food waste and to offer you the fairest price since only precise quantities will be cooked.

- Welcoming diner on Wednesday 29th will be served after the opening, around 8pm. The place has to be define
- Thursday 30th lunch will be services at the competition site in a heated tent between 11am-15pm.
- Thursday 30th diner will be services at the competition site in a heated tent between 19:00 pm - 20:00 pm. It is services at the competition site in a heated tent.
- Friday lunch will be services at the competition site in a heated tent between 11:30am - 2pm. It is services at the competition site in a heated tent.
- Friday 31st diner will be services at the competition site in a heated tent between 20:30 pm - 21:00 pm. It is services at the competition site in a heated tent.
- Sunday 1st Diner will be services at the competition site in a heated tent between just after the finales and before the party.

To limit waste and to be able to take your food away, we ask you to bring:

- Your own water bottle and cup. No plastic bottles will be distributed.
- Your own cutlery and lunch box / tupperware. No disposable tableware will be provided for lunches.



Did you say "Gorzderette" ?

The Gorzderette is an annual sporting and cultural event, centered around reimagined mountain sports, but most importantly around the ice tower of Champagny-en-Vanoise, a one-of-a-kind structure offering opportunities to discover and practice ice climbing, both for beginners and for the most seasoned competitors.

What exactly happens there ? On Saturday, February 1, 2025, you can join a frosty tournament day as a duo, featuring a variety of quirky sporting challenges you won't find anywhere else... You can also watch films during the screening evening on Friday, January 31, 2025, and participate in activities at the ice tower site, like the concert night on Saturday, February 1.

And what about Sunday, February 2 ? As a participant in the Gorzderette, you can book a slot to climb the ice tower by registering during Saturday's tournament. Equipment is provided if needed, and professional qualified belayers ensure safety.

What about food ? Registration for the Gorzderette includes lunch on Saturday, February 1, and Sunday, February 2, 2025. On-site, sweet snacks are available to support local associations, and a refreshment bar will quench even the greatest thirst. There's also a dinner option on Saturday evening, available through pre-booking and payment.

Who can participate ? Everyone is welcome, starting from age 13. Whether you're a specialist in a discipline, an all-rounder, an experienced athlete, or a complete beginner, whether you come with family or solo, to win or simply for the joy of discovery...

Why do we do all this ? The idea is to bring together all winter sports enthusiasts, from stars to beginners, for three days of activities and tournaments where everyone gets to compete and try out different disciplines. You'll benefit from professional guidance, get to test equipment, and share convivial moments: meals, activities, concerts... And you'll also witness an exceptional show featuring the best international ice climbers: the final of the ice climbing difficulty competition! The shuttle is a free service, is meant for the residents of Champagny (tourists & inhabitants) and is not open for off-piste skiers arriving at Champagny-le-Haut (who could reserve a taxi). CAUTION: the vehicles capacity is limited. At certain periods of over-crowding and time, the place is not guaranteed for all people. Thanks for your understanding.

Visa information and assistance process

Are you a foreigner and wish to stay in France for less than 3 months? You must have a so-called short-stay visa (type C). This visa is common to the countries of the Schengen area: Germany, Austria, Belgium, Denmark, Spain, Estonia, Finland, France, Greece, Hungary, Iceland (outside the EU), Italy, Latvia, Liechtenstein (outside the EU), Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Norway (outside EU), Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Czech Republic, Slovakia, Slovenia, Sweden, Switzerland (outside EU). It allows you to stay in France and in the other countries of the Schengen area, with some exceptions. It is also necessary to hold other documents which vary according to the purpose of the stay.
