^{*}U16 will climb on top rope, all other age groups will lead climb their routes.

Quota for youth finals: min 3, max 6 climber per category. 50% qualifies rounded down. So for example: 7 climbers; 3,5 qualifies which will be rounded down to 3.

When a youth climber climbs the senior final, his or her youth finale start place will be replaced with the next not qualified climber when it would result in less then 3 climbers in the youth final category.

^{**} Qualification rules youth finals: when a youth category climber (also) qualifies for the senior finals, the climber can only climb one final and has to choose which one.

How to get to Utrecht, the Netherlands?

Car

Utrecht is located in the heart of the Netherlands. Several major highways pass the city, like A2, A12, A27 and A28. Parking is easy since the climbing wall is built against a car park.

Airplane

Schiphol is the major airport in the Netherlands. You can reach the venue within one hour from Schiphol airport by taking the Intercity train to Utrecht CS, then take tram 22 to *P+R Science Park*. The tram terminal is right behind the venue (under the car park) but only rides on working days (Monday to Friday).

Train

Go to Utrecht Central Station and take tram 22 to P+R Science Park. See directions Airplane. You can check 9292.nl for travel advice

Note: From Utrecht Central Station the tram only runs on working days. In the weekend you need to take bus line 28 to the venue.

Overview Public Transport Utrecht

Accommodation

You have several hotel options in the city of Utrecht, just check booking.com or any other online booking platform.

The best accommodation option is probably the <u>Youth Hostel Stay Okay</u> in Bunnik. This is just 3km from the venue. The hostel hires bicycles so you cycle in 10 minutes to the venue or simply take a scenic walk in 35 minutes.

2025 Venue

The competition wall is built against a solid concrete climbing wall. It gets a winter dress of wooden panels when the leaves start falling. We added a roof section for competitions. In 2024 we extended the competition wall with two extra lead lines. This resulted in two competition walls with both about 15 meters height. The original competition wall has about 14 degrees overhang on average. The new 2024 competition wall is on average about vertical.
