

UIAA Ice Climbing License, Event Entry and Appeal Fees Policy

1. All fees are the sole responsibility of the member federations and/or the athlete (this is to be agreed between the athlete/team and the member federation) and are as follows:
 - a. Senior International license fees – 100 Euro for athletes; 50 Euro for team officials (if a licensed athlete is acting as a team official they don't need to pay the team official fee).
 - b. Youth International license fee – 0 Euro
 - c. Senior Competition entry fees – 75 Euro for 1 discipline, 125 Euro for 2.
 - d. World Youth competition entry fees – 75 Euro for 1 discipline, 125 Euro for 2.
 - e. Continental Youth competition entry fees - 50 Euro
 - f. Appeals fees – 50 Euro.
2. A senior athlete only requires a UIAA license for World Cup and Championship events, Continental Cups do not require a license. An athlete's license fee can be paid in two ways:
 - b. By the athlete – by credit or debit card at the first competition they attend of the season (a receipt can be provided upon request and will be emailed to the athlete after the competition).
 - c. By the member federation – an invoice will be sent to the federation by the UIAA at the end of the season for the total number of athlete licenses that the federation is responsible for.
3. A member federation shall pay the UIAA the amount invoiced for licence fees before the date specified on the invoice. Failure to do so shall be dealt with as set out in Article 6.
4. The competition entry fees will be paid by the athlete or Team Official to the organizer during registration (the organiser can provide a receipt upon request).
5. If a Continental Championship is run as part of a World Cup event with no extra routes/prize money etc, then only one fee per athlete should be charged.
6. Appeals fees are paid by card payment after the appeal is considered and has been subsequently rejected. The athlete/coach submitting the appeal is responsible for this payment (a receipt can be provided upon request).
7. A member federation that is in default of UIAA regulations governing payment of fees shall, in accordance with the regulations and bylaws, be liable to have its membership suspended and, ultimately, withdrawn.
8. The scale of all fees shall be decided and published annually by the UIAA.
